- Ability to develop concepts and ideas in oral and written form.
- Knowledge of the learning process and child development.
- Ability to work cooperatively with parents, the school and the district in providing service to students.
- Possess strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work cooperatively with students, teams, and groups.
- Ability to differentiate instruction based on the needs of the students.
- Knowledge of testing and data analysis.

Experience, Skills, and Certification Preferred:

- Completion of an approved teacher training program.
- Certification or endorsement in more than one academic area.
